Steps in making a Band Saw Box . . .




1. Draw, and attach design to block of wood.



2. Cut out the box, cutting on the outside of the line.



3. Cut off the back of the box.




4. Cut out the drawer, cutting on the line, using a 3/8" or 1/4" blade. In choosing the entry point, best to cut with the grain.






5. Glue, and clamp the outer ring of the box.



6. Cut off the front and back of the drawer.



7. Cut out the interior of the drawer.



8. Sand the interior of the drawer(s), but not completely smooth



9. Sand the interior of the box.




10. Finish sand the interior of the box.



11. Glue the back on the box.



12. Glue the front, and back onto the drawer



13. Clamp drawer and box.



14. Sand outside of drawer



15. Sand outside of box




16. Finish sand everything, but not the interior of the drawer(s)



17. Make handle for the drawer



18. To flock the drawer, tape off the area that is not to be flocked



19. Seal the area to be flocked with sealer, polyurethane, or . . .



20. Line a box with wax paper, or plastic



21. Apply a generous, even coat of undercoat adhesive, in the same color of the flocking fibers




22. Spray flocking fibers, very liberally, immediately after undercoat has been applied



23. After overnight drying, shake out loose fibers



24. Remove tape



25. Save excess fibers for future use



26. Attach handle to front of drawer



27. Add finish to box and drawer



28. Enjoy using your band saw box!
